CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Mike Cole called the meeting to order at 10 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

▶1. NORTH FLORIDA TPO MINUTES OF MAY 11, 2023

Christian Whitehurst moved to approve the Consent Agenda; Betsy Condon seconded; motion unanimously carried.

<u>AGENDA</u>

A. FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

Representing the Finance Committee, Angela Session reported the March and April financials have been accepted.

Ms. Session asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

►B. APPROVAL OF THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) FOR FY 2023/24 THROUGH FY 2027/28

Elizabeth De Jesus presented the draft Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28 for approval.

At the May meeting, a complete draft was presented as well as a TIP PowerPoint presentation. County specific PowerPoint virtual presentations occurred during the month of May. In addition, a regional TIP virtual public meeting was held May 17.

Ms. De Jesus asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

Reba Ludlow moved to approve the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2023/24 through FY 2027/28; Christian Whitehurst seconded; motion unanimously carried.

►C. PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SU FUNDING FOR FY 2024/25 THROUGH FY 2028/29

Jeff Sheffield presented the draft project recommendations for SU funding for FY 2024/25 through FY 2028/29. A list of projects recommended for SU funding was provided at the May meeting.

Mr. Sheffield asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

Fernando Acosta-Rua moved to approve the project recommendations for SU funding for FY 2024/25 through FY 2028/29; Debbie Buckland seconded; motion unanimously carried.

►D. PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CMAQ FUNDING FOR FY 2024/25 THROUGH FY 2028/29

Jeff Sheffield presented the draft project recommendations for CMAQ funding for FY 2024/25 through FY 2028/29. A list of projects recommended for CMAQ funding was provided at the May meeting.

Mr. Sheffield asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

Fernando Acosta-Rua moved to approve the project recommendations for CMAQ funding for FY 2024/25 through FY 2028/29; Mark McManus seconded; motion unanimously carried.

E. LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE

Clark Letter gave a brief update on the 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). We will use 2020 as the base year. The 2050 LRTP will be adopted in November 2024 along with the Needs Plan and Cost Feasible Plan. The Needs Plan is our existing and committed roadway network for our region and projects out the population into the future to determine which roadways are deficient based on the population growth. The Cost Feasible Plan adds in which roadways are included to satisfy those needs. The projects included in the Cost Feasible Plan are the only ones that can utilize federal funds.

As part of the LRTP update, we are changing our regional planning model from an activity-based model and going back to a four-step model. This will make it simpler to use.

The LRTP Steering Committee will be comprised of members from our TAC and CAC and anyone else who has an interest to participate. Staff anticipates the first meeting to be in August following the TAC meeting.

Mr. Letter asked for questions.

Jeff Sheffield commented this is not the most exciting process, but it is the
most necessary. If you expect some of your county's projects to have a
path to funding, they must end up in the Cost Feasible Plan. We
emphasized to the TAC members they need to participate in all five of the
stakeholder meetings.

F. CLAY COUNTY DIRT ROAD STUDY

Martha Moore of Benesch gave a brief presentation on the Clay County Dirt Road Study.

Ms. Moore asked for questions. There were no questions at this time.

G. SMART NORTH FLORIDA UPDATE

Jeff Sheffield gave the following update.

- Two pilot projects on Wells Road are complete. They are Street Scope that uses an Al projection to look at hazardous conditions along the roadway, and Street Simplified is an intersection analysis using Al to identify hazardous conditions.
- Continuing to see interest from FDOT District 2 in what SNF has been doing. FDOT is willing to provide us with a problem statement and let us suggest a possible solution. If they decide to go with that solution, the

particular non-profit would conduct a pilot program to test the technology at no cost to FDOT. This scenario continues to build our partnership with FDOT and positions us to be eligible for discretionary dollars.

J. <u>EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT</u>

Jeff Sheffield gave the following update.

House Bill 425 does not affect the TPO directly; however, the following changes have occurred.

- 1. Pasco, Pinellas and Hillsborough Counties have to submit a report in December of what a merger of these three MPOs would look like. The reality is that many MPOs are crossing over each other in south Florida. We are a regionally independent MPO with none of these issues.
- 2. MPOs cannot lobby. The only lobbying capacity we had was the MPOAC. The MPOAC can no longer lobby or receive local funds.
- 3. Space Florida must now coordinate with the MPOAC in statewide planning efforts.
- Funding is available to assist with converting your fleets to alternative fuels. The consultant will do the evaluation to see the benefits to your county.
- 4. Marci needs the data from your counties to complete the All Fuels Master Plan update. If you have not already done so, please provide her with your information as soon as possible.
- 5. There are 75 clean fuels coalitions in the country. The North Florida Clean Fuels Coalition displaces more petroleum than any other coalition in the U.S.

K. <u>SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION'S REPORT</u>

- Secretary Evans thanked Mr. Sheffield for the continued partnership with FDOT. FDOT will provide the TPO with a problem statement and let us suggest a possible solution.
- Ribbon cutting for SunTrax in Auburndale will take place tomorrow. This 400-acre test track can also be used for autonomous vehicles.
- Bids open this morning at 11 a.m. for the I-95 Design/Build project south of town. The job is estimated at \$240 million.

• Secretary Evans challenged his staff to reach 100,000 people, targeting high school students and young adults, with FDOT's safety message.

Ryan Trespalacio gave an update on the outreach of the safety message. To date, FDOT has reached 37,000 students in-person and 150,000 through social media. If any of you wish to provide recommendations and/or contact information for groups to target, we would appreciate it.

Betsy Condon asked for Mr. Trespalacios's contact information.

Ryan Trespalacios responded he will provide his contact information.

L. <u>AUTHORITY REPORTS</u>

Fernando Acosta-Rua – Jacksonville Aviation Authority – Air traffic has increased and surpassed pre-pandemic levels. The Board approved a new parking garage with 2,000 spaces. Boeing at Cecil Field should be completed mid-January 2024.

Soo Gilvarry – JAXPORT – Consentino Group, the Spain-based global leader in production and distribution, will build their first manufacturing facility in Jacksonville. Construction will begin in August 2025 and create approximately 180 jobs. Convoy Beverage Alliance, a Florida-based warehousing and transportation provider for alcoholic beverage companies, has joined JAXPORT's foreign trade zone. SSA Marine, JAXPORT's terminal operator, has been working on a modernization project on Blount Island. They have completed three out of eight phases. By 2024, the terminal will have 93 acres of pavement to accommodate taller containers. Southeast Toyota will start construction on a 300,000 square foot auto processing facility on Blount Island. This will create 800 jobs.

Debbie Buckland – Jacksonville Transportation Authority – The JTA partnered with Generation WOW, WTS Northeast Florida, and WTS International for Transportation YOU – a program designed to encourage careers for young women in transportation. Students from four local high schools visited the JTA and were able to tour the JTA campus and hear from exceptional women leaders about the transportation industry. Generation WOW is a girl-centric movement bringing teen girls together to learn, be inspired, and form valuable connections. The programs build future leaders and inspire authentic connections through mentorships and education.

Continuing on our path to becoming a regional mobility integrator, the JTA hosted the Regional Transit Working Group May 18. There was a great turnout both inperson and virtually, with representation from Baker, Clay, Nassau, Putnam, and St. Johns Counties, as well as representatives from the Northeast Florida

Regional Council, the City of Jacksonville, FDOT, and of course, our co-host, the North Florida TPO. I want to personally thank Jeff Sheffield and Clark Letter for their commitment to re-establishing the Working Group. We held a very productive meeting that served not only to present the work that the JTA does from a regional perspective but collaborative opportunities that can lead to greater inter-connected services across county lines. We presented the Clay County Transit Study to the Clay County Board of Commissioners in March, and discussed the upcoming Nassau County Transit Study. We also discussed fare collection, operations, and service coordination, the Clean Fuels Coalition and Alternative Fuels Master Plan, the urban boundary and functional class updates, the 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan, the Regional First-Mile/Last-Mile Study, and the status of our web-based trip-planning tool, Transportal. We intend for these to become regular meetings with the goal of advancing regional transportation efforts among entities.

Finally, I regret to inform you that Bus Operator 1064, Mr. Amos Ealey, who was one of the first African American operators of the JTA, passed away May 10. Since his retirement, Mr. Ealey has returned to participate in events and share his knowledge. He was previously highlighted in our Making Moves show, and this past February he came to speak to operators to share his experience on what it was like to be an African American bus operator in the 1960s. We lost a special one in Mr. Ealey. He was truly a champion of JTA. He will be missed, but we are deeply honored to have him be part of the JTA family and to have met him. Our condolences go out to Mr. Ealey's family and loved ones.

Mike Cole – Nassau County Ocean Highway and Port Authority – Working on Resiliency Plan. Received approval from the City for road designation and roads within the port footprint. Working with FDOT for signage for those roads. Our Executive Director will get with the TPO regarding Clean Fuels. Budget preparations are underway.

Reba Ludlow – St. Augustine-St. Johns County Airport Authority – No commercial service in the near future. Wings and Wheels will be held June 17. We are still looking for an Executive Director and Chief Financial Officer. In the process of changing our name back to St. Augustine Airport.

Mark McManus (for Captain Marcos Cantu) U.S. Navy – Mayport has partnered with the University of Georgia Institute for Resilient Infrastructure Studies Group to conduct a resiliency project on A-1-A between Little Jetties Park and the Coast Guard station to stabilize the shoreline for erosion. They are also doing a project near the fuel tanks at Mayport. The University of Georgia submitted an application for a Fish and Wildlife Grant for this project.

• Debbie Buckland asked the amount of the grant.

Mr. McManus responded he does not know the amount, but they were approved for a full submission.

The Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) is the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization's (TPO's) two-year tasked based budget. The North Florida TPO is requesting to change the title and scope of UPWP Task 5.21 from "Amelia Island Trail Phase 5 Feasibility Study" to "Pedestrian & Bicycle Corridor Safety Studies". The study purpose is to conduct pedestrian and bicycle safety studies on Barnwell Road from SR 200 to Oyster Bay Dr. and Pine Street from Henry Smith Road to CR 108. Both roadways are in Nassau County, FL.

This amendment is being made at the request of Nassau County after they received an appropriation to conduct the Amelia Island Trail feasibility study. There is no change to the budget for this task.

Task 5.21 — Pedestrian & Bicycle Corridor Safety Studies (Nassau County) - TPO

Responsible Agency

North Florida Transportation Planning Organization. This subtask is anticipated to be completed through the use of a North Florida TPO general consultant.

Purpose

The study purpose is to conduct pedestrian and bicycle safety studies on Barnwell Road from SR 200 to Oyster Bay Drive and Pine Street from Henry Smith Road to CR 108. Both roadways are in Nassau County, FL. The TPO will work in partnership with the City of Yulee, Nassau County and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to provide countermeasures for implementation that may include traditional strategies such as constructing sidewalks or installing pedestrian signals as well as lower-cost improvements that are quicker to implement.

Previous Work

Regional Bike and Pedestrian Study, 2023

Required Activities
